## Healthy Volunteers Needed for Research!

### Who is eligible?

ANYONE can participate, as long as they are between the ages of 10 and 89 and have no known neurological or cognitive impairments. We welcome family participation!

### What will my visit be like?

Your visit will begin with a few paper-and-pencil questionnaires to assess your memory, thinking skills, and your mood/emotions. Afterwards, we will move over to our MSPT iPad where you will complete a series of interactive games and activities that will collect information about your memory, vision, thinking skills, and motoric function. Visits typically only last about an hour, but will depend on the pacing of the individual.

### Why should I participate?

The MSPT is being tested to develop a better way to assess cognition, vision, motor function, and balance in patients that have multiple sclerosis (MS). However, before we are able to evaluate patients with MS, we first need to have data on our healthy controls (that's you!). Your participation in this study will assist us in creating a nation-wide normative database of information that could help us use the MSPT to provide a more efficient way of assessing multiple sclerosis.
